### CONTAGIOUS EQUINE METRITIS (CEM) & OTHER BACTERIAL DISEASES

Before covering, please ensure that the sanitary status of the mare is valid. Are considered high risk mares those who have had previous contact with CEMO or who originate from countries outside France, Germany, Ireland, Italy and the United Kingdom in the last 12 months. #### HIGH RISK MARES :

- Two negative clitoral swabs (sinus and fossa) taken at least seven days apart and one negative endometrial swab, both taken after 1st January.  
Clitoral and endometrial swab test results must certify negative culture or PCR results for Taylorella equigenitalis (CEMO), Klebsiella pneumoniae (capsule types 1, 2, and 5) and Pseudomonas aeruginosa by a Horserace Betting Levy Board Designated Laboratory (UK, IRE) or other National Approved Laboratory in Germany, Ireland or France.
- Then follow the usual requirement.



## EQUINE VIRAL ARTERITIS (EVA)

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EVA tests to be taken after January 1st dating of less than 30 days before first cover:

- Either a negative serological result or a negative ELISA-AVE result.
- Either two positive serological results that are stable or declining, taken 14 days apart, analyzed by a registered and national approved laboratory
- Either a serological result, stable positive or declining in comparison with the result from the previous year analyzed by a registered an national approved laboratory



## COMPULSORY VACCINATIONS

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**EQUINE INFLUENZA AND RHINOPNEUMONIA : Before covering**

- Either a primary vaccinations : second injection between 3 to 6 weeks following first vaccine, and then a booster at least once a year, recommended every 6 months.
- Either at least one annual booster vaccine for the past three years

Any break in the vaccinations protocol requires a new set of primary vaccinations before covering



## EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANAEMIA (EIA)

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A negative result is recommended after January 1st and dated less than 30 days before covering.



## DOURINE TEST

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It is recommended for all mares coming from Italy to do a blood test for Dourine : one negative serological result dated less than 3 months before arriving at the boarding stud.



## ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS

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- If a mare is changed from one stallion to another during the breeding season, all tests have to be redone 7 days after the last cover by the previous stallion. The results have to be send before covering.
- If the mare moves to another boarding stud during the breeding season, all the tests have to be redone.
