LIVRET & VACCINATIONS

- 1st page, French Markings page with the SIRE and Microship numbers
 - Flu : Primary vaccination 21 - 60 days > Booster injection 120 - 180 days = **Every 6 months**
 - EHV 1&4 : Primary vaccination 21 - 60 days > Booster injection 120 - 180 days = **Every 6 months**
- * Any break in the vaccinations protocol requires a new set of primary vaccinations before covering

ARTERITE VIRALE (AVE)

- EVA tests to be taken after January 1st dating of less than 30 days before first cover
- * if positive result: two positive serological results that are stable or declining, taken at least 15 days apart (analyzed by a registered and national approved laboratory)

CONTAGIOUS EQUINE METRITIS (CEM)

Swabs from the 1st of January

Clitoral Sinus and Fossa

- Taylorella Equigenitalis
- Klebsiella Pneumoniae
- Pseudomonas Aeruginosa

Endometrial

- Taylorella Equigenitalis
- Klebsiella Pneumoniae
- Pseudomonas Aeruginosa
- Associated Flora

Specific Cases

- If your mare had previous contact with CEMO or who originate from countries outside France, Germany, Ireland, Italy and the United Kingdom in the last 12 months : she is considered "High Risk Mare". In this case you will need : Two negative clitoral swabs (sinus and fossa) taken at least seven days apart and one negative endometrial swab, both taken after 1st January.
- If Klebsiella Pneumoniae positive : Capsule Types K1, K2 and K5
- If cover on the foal heat : Endometrial CEM swabs before the covering with Vet certificate.
- If Associated Flora is positive: treatment according to the results with vet certificate

COGGINS (recommended)

Test to be taken after January 1st dating of less than 30 days before first cover

DOURINE (For mares from Italy)

Test to be taken after January 1st dating of less than 30 days before first cover

MUST KNOW

- Maiden mares must be unshod and have been mounted by a teaser
- Mares on foal heat do not have priority status
- If a mare changes stallion, repeat all swabs and tests at least seven days after the last mating with the previous stallion (negative results should be sent before the new mating)
- We reserve the right to demand further tests and veterinary additional certificates
- In the event of the non-respect of this hygiene notice or of dangerous behavior, the Haras de la Tuilerie reserves the right to refuse the mating
